VOTE: Pennsylvania Primary – May 17, 2022 polls open 7am - 8pm

- **PA Primary voter registration deadline - May 2**
Note: Mail-in or Absentee ballots: As an annual mail voter, you must submit a request to vote by mail ballot every year. More info here: [Annual Mail-in Voter List \(pa.gov\)](#)
- **Deadline to request a mail-in/absentee ballot - May 10**
- **Deadline for mail-in/absentee ballots *to arrive* at your county election office - May 17** (note that postmarks are not enough)
- **Last day for early/on-demand voting at the County Board of Elections - May 16**

Inflation—and What Democrats Should Say About It


Robert Hubbell's piece in *Today's Edition Newsletter* on 4/13/22 lays out the situation:
