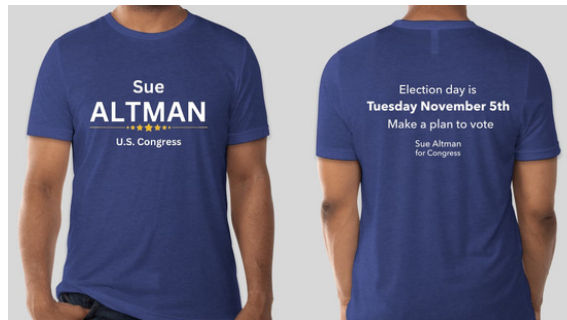
Sign up for Indivisible's Neighbor2Neighbor
