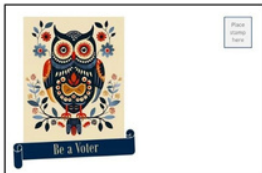

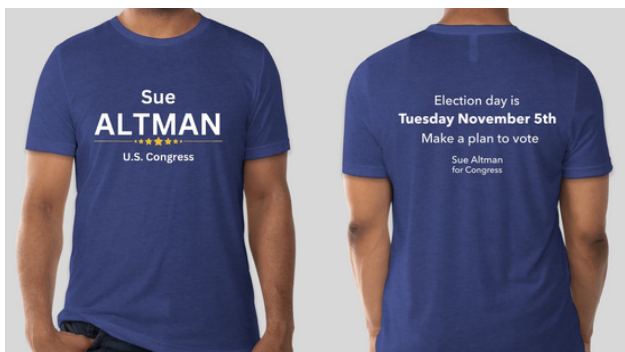


### What is Neighbor2Neighbor?
