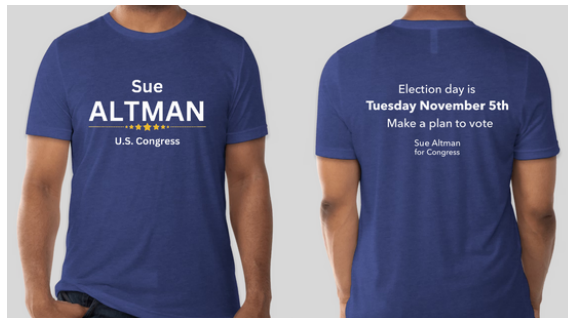


What is Neighbor2Neighbor?
