What is Neighbor2Neighbor?

Neighbor2Neighbor is a new innovative tool created by Indivisible. It provides a low barrier/high impact way to canvass. It's the most convenient way to have conversations with your neighbors about the upcoming election! The goal is to knock 200,000 doors in House, Senate, and Presidential battlegrounds across the U.S. in 2024. It's going to take neighbors talking to neighbors to fight back against MAGA extremism and secure our rights. Let's do this!

When you sign up, you commit to talking with ten people in your neighborhood. The people will be like minded voters. You will receive a simple script and a piece of literature to leave with your neighbor. It's simple, no app, no reporting - just you knocking on neighbors doors to let them know about our efforts and our Indivisible groups they can join if they'd like. [Click here](#) to sign up!

There are so many ways to get involved, but we hope you will consider one of the most effective ways to get people to vote. Door-to-door canvassing! In canvassing, people are trained and given a script, then sent off with an experienced buddy to talk to registered democrats and independents. 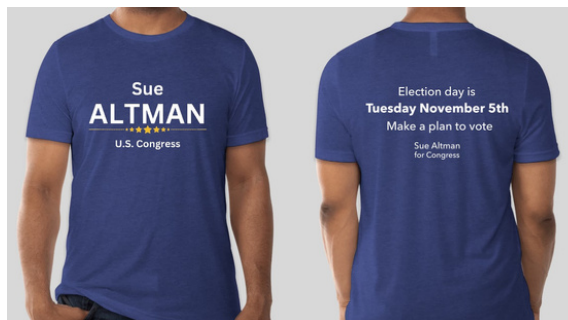
