OK now down to business! Below is an updated Action Alert list. Go forth and call, write or email your representatives! Object to the:

- SAVE Act - Will require documentary proof of citizenship for voting. Will threaten the ability of marginalized U.S. citizens who lack documentation to vote.
- Laken Riley Act - Will increase risk of incarcerations of the undocumented and require mandatory detention of certain noncitizens, including any undocumented person or DACA recipient.
- Trump's Cabinet nominees (Kash Patel (FBI Director), Tulsi Gabbard (Director of National Intelligence), RFK Jr. (Health and Human Services secretary), Pete Hegseth (Defense secretary) and Linda McMahon (Education secretary))

Question: Why should I bother contacting my representative? I live in NJ and have two Democratic Senators and a Democratic Congressman! I have a million things to do today so I'll just skip it, thanks!

Answer: Bad idea! Our representatives get tired and busy too! They need our energy and good vibes cheering them on (pat them on the proverbial back when they do something well) and encouragement to keep fighting on our behalf. They also need to know what's important to us cuz we're the ones who can basically fire them in the next election! Every day, staff tally how many calls constituents have made about a particular issue. This guides their voting behavior!

Voice your objection to the SAVE Act. Call your Legislators today!

The Safeguard American Voter Eligibility (SAVE) Act (HR22) formerly HR 8281, was re-introduced recently. It will require documentary proof of citizenship, such as a passport or real ID, to register to vote and is a huge voter suppression effort-- effectively a modern poll tax. Contact Your Senators and Urge them to Reject the Laken Riley Act

On January 7, the House of Representatives passed the Laken Riley Act, H.R. 29. Soon, it will likely go to a vote in the Senate. If this bill passes, it would:

- Require mandatory detention of certain noncitizens, including any undocumented person or DACA recipient, arrested for burglary, theft, larceny, or shoplifting-related offenses, even if they are never charged with a crime.
- Give state attorneys general, including notoriously anti-immigrant ones from states like Texas and Louisiana, the power to dictate immigration policy at the federal level and on the international stage.
