A U.S. House of Representatives vote on a budget resolution that would likely cut up to \$880 million in cuts to Medicaid will happen this week!

Contact your U.S. House of Representatives member TODAY and tell them you value people with disabilities and oppose budget cuts to Medicaid! Trump promised not to cut Medicaid, but the current House proposal to cut \$880 billion dollars from the House, Energy, and Commerce budget (a large chunk of which includes Medicaid) would inevitably lead to steep cuts to Medicaid according to both Republican and Democrat lawmakers. It is simply impossible to cut the budget this much without cutting Medicaid, and people with significant disabilities comprise too much of that budget to remain unscathed. People with developmental disabilities rely on Medicaid for assistance with daily living activities, personal care, specialized therapies, housing, and more.
