Oppose the SAVE Act Voter
Suppression Bill Today!

H.R. 22, the SAVE (“Safeguard American Voter Eligibility”) Act, is a voter suppression bill. Student IDs, Drivers Licenses, Military IDs, and more would no longer be valid proof to cast your vote in our democratic system. With roughly 150,000,000 Americans without a passport and many more without proper access to their birth certificate, this could be one of the most destructive voter suppression bills in modern history. 69 million women lack a birth certificate that matches their current legal name, creating additional barriers.
