Yesterday was our March Community Gathering and it was jam packed with great information! We hope you found it helpful in your tireless activism work! If you couldn't attend, because we reached capacity, know that we're working hard to find a location big enough for our ever expanding tribe of activists!

Thank you to all who attended Saturday's morning Zoom meeting! Last week, Indivisible National co-founders Ezra Levin and Leah Greenberg convened a Zoom meeting of Indivisible leaders from across the country. At that meeting, 91% of the leaders present voted to call for Senator Schumer to step down as Minority Leader. Indivisible National then asked that all local Indivisible groups consider this same question. On Saturday, Indivisible Lambertville/New Hope (ILNH) hosted a Zoom meeting for our activists where ILNH organizers presented arguments on both sides of the question and a vote was held. It was decided in advance that we would sign onto the call for resignation if at least 60% voted in favor of it. Given that 72% of our activists voted in favor of the motion, ILNH now joins other groups across the country in calling for Senator Schumer to step down as Minority Leader.
