Protect 50,000 federal workers from politicized firings	The 30-day window to leave a comment closes on May 23. The Office of Personnel Management (OPM) has proposed a new rule that will reclassify 50,000 federal workers, making it easier to fire them for politically motivated reasons. On the Federal Register, submit a comment opposing the rule by May 23!
CALL NOW: Stop Crypto Corruption	Democrats are currently working with Republicans on a bill called the GENIUS Act that claims to “regulate” a strand of crypto called “stablecoins.” But in reality, it would enable illicit uses of crypto currency, open the door to blatant frauds, and imperil financial stability. Documenting How Social Security Staff Cuts Affect NJ residents	As the Trump administration cuts the number of Social Security Administration (SSA) staff, a group of concerned citizens is trying to assemble information on the difficulties some NJ residents experience in speaking to the remaining SSA workers (by phone or in person) about their Social Security or Medicare benefits. The group plans to disseminate this information to pressure Republicans in congress to reverse the staffing cuts.
