Let's be sure our Representatives know where we stand! This bill will strip working families of \$1.5 trillion in Medicaid, SNAP, and other essential programs—all to pay for more than \$4.5 trillion in tax breaks for the super-rich. However, **this bill is far from a done deal.** The House Budget Committee struggles to get their party's megabill out of committee and to a full vote. GOP leaders will need just about every vote in their caucus to pass this thing -- including the votes of vulnerable Republicans who have already expressed concerns about some of these draconian cuts.

June 14th No Kings Protests are in the planning across the country - 650 currently, and growing! This includes an Indivisible Lambertville-New Hope special kick off event in the morning! See more below.

A note from ILNH Leadership Team regarding the New Hope Mayoral Race:

We have typically stayed out of primary contests and under normal circumstances we do not get involved in primary races, because we assume good faith among all candidates and good judgment among all voters. However, this particular instance is not normal. It appears there is some bad-faith dealing and a lot of false information intended to mislead voters, and we are making an exception and getting involved because we feel we need to do our part to make sure voters have the information they need. It is in that spirit that we are sharing a note Kristin Donnelly sent to New Hope Democrats a couple of weeks ago. "NO KINGS" is a national day of action and mass mobilization—on Saturday, June 14—in response to the increasing authoritarian excesses and corruption of the Trump administration. It is also Flag Day.

Indivisible Lambertville-New Hope (ILNH), along with our partners in the Indivisible One New Jersey (IONJ) coalition, is taking action on this day of defiance to reject authoritarianism. In doing so, we are sending a message to President Trump: No Kings! The American flag belongs to all of us!

We will perform a "card stunt." We will gather on a large field and hold cards that together create two field-sized images: one supporting our democracy, and the other, reclaiming

the American Flag. A drone will capture the event and we will share it on social media as a kickoff to No Kings Day.
