

Hello friends.

Yesterday, activists assembled on Ely Field in Lambertville to declare "No Kings" with 800-square-feet of hand-painted posters! As you know, the event was part of a mass, nationwide, peaceful protest rejecting authoritarianism, billionaire-first politics, and the militarization of our democracy.

"Since the Trump administration took over in January, the level of authoritarianism, overreach and corruption has threatened people's lives and livelihood, the US economy and our country's standing in the world. All of us here today - in Lambertville, and across the U.S. and the globe - stand for democracy, for the people, and for the values on which our nation was founded." (Cindi Sternfeld, founder, Indivisible Lambertville/New Hope)

The "No Kings" mobilization was a direct response to President Trump's self-aggrandizing \$45 million birthday celebration, an event funded by taxpayers, while millions are told there's no money for Social Security, SNAP, Medicaid, or public schools. This mobilization was bigger than political disagreement. The administration has defied courts, pardoned criminals, deported and sent troops against American citizens, disappeared people off the streets, and slashed services.

"We are in the millions - people of different genders, races, abilities and identities - coming together in communities across the country to reject strongman politics and corruption.
