Shut Down Moshannon Protest

August 24, 2-4pm

Philipsburg Memorial Park, across the street from the Philipsburg Borough Office located at 4 N Centre St, Philipsburg, PA 16866

Moshannon Valley Processing Center is the largest ICE detention center in the Northeast United States. ICE sends individuals detained from across the Northeast and Mid-Atlantic, and is expected to reach its maximum capacity of 1,870 people in a matter of weeks. There have been documented and verified abuses of detained individuals, indicating a profound disregard for the human and civil rights our Constitution guarantees to every person in America. On August 24, residents from across Pennsylvania will gather to express outrage and demand that this facility be shut down. Our Congressional representatives, who have the legal authority to enter all federal facilities, will demand access to report on the current conditions inside and to speak with individuals currently detained. Other VIPs and elected officials will speak against the facility and demand its closure. CLICK HERE to register!
