Signs of Solidarity - Across the country, ICE agents are entering small businesses without warrants — detaining workers, frightening customers, and spreading fear in our communities. These raids often happen without warning, carried out by masked agents in plain clothes with no visible identification. Indivisible has a campaign to talk to business owners and provide them with signs that have a clear message: immigrants are welcome here, and our community stands united against harassment. We are looking for people to go out and talk with businesses and ask them to display these signs, as well as educate them on how having a "STOP - Employees Only" sign can prevent ICE from coming into an area without a legal warrant signed by a judge.
