We demand that **SPOTIFY** terminate all ICE and DHS advertising contracts. Until the demand is met, we will: 1) Cancel paid subscriptions and give a reason (i.e. "I'm cancelling until Spotify terminates ICE ads."), 2) Stop streaming the free ad-based service, 3) Support artists elsewhere (for example, on Patreon, [TIDAL](#), or [Apple music](#).), 4) Go to <https://indivisible.org/cancel-spotify>.

We demand that **STARBUCKS** staff better, give higher pay, and resolve hundreds of unfair labor practice charges to unionized (and hopefully all other) employees.
