

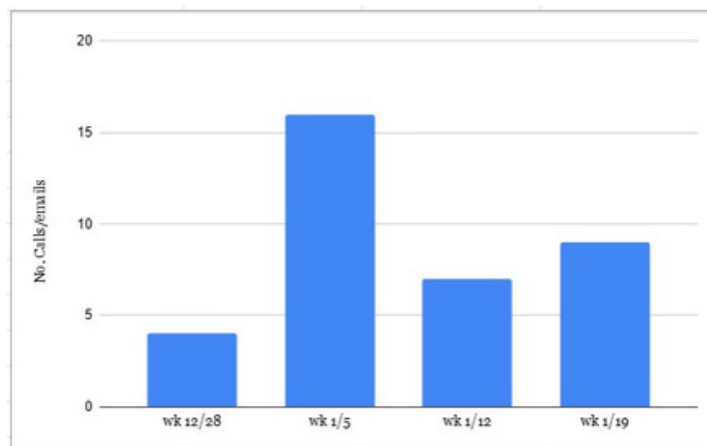


Dear Friends,

ILNH held our first candidate debate!! Allow me to toot our collective horns. This was a monumental effort brought together by many volunteers and it went wonderfully. On 1/29, professional journalist Laura Jones moderated our debate of Democratic candidates Beth Ellen Adubato, Megan O'Rourke, Brian Varela, Michael Roth and Tina Shah, who are vying to represent New Jersey's 7th Congressional District (CD7). Prior to the debate, six candidates answered 16 questions posed by ILNH. Responses were scored using a rubric specific to each individual question. Thirty-four reviewers assessed the responses, and all questions were assessed by 4 reviewers. The candidate answers were blinded, meaning reviewers did not see the candidate names, only reference numbers. The results of this effort are located on our [website](#) in the red hyperlinks!
